1. Byron charges and hits MacKenzie

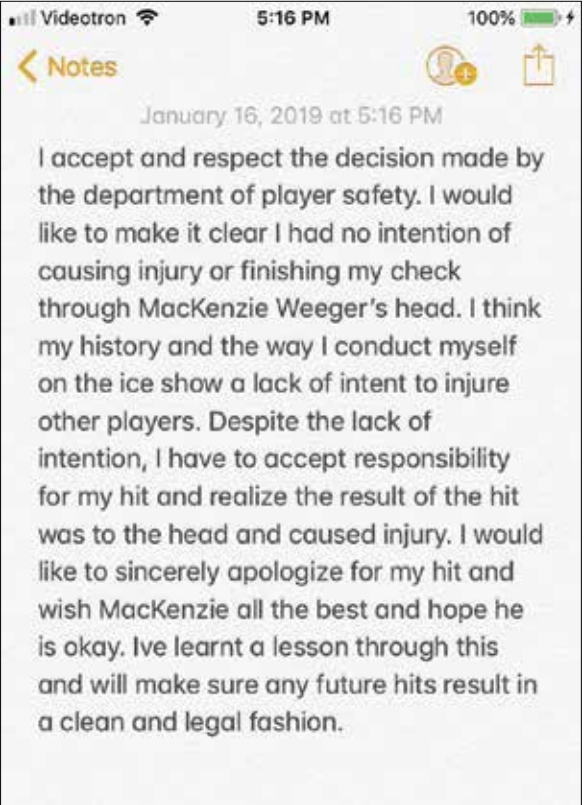
On January 15th, 2019 during a game between the Canadiens and the Panthers, Paul Byron charged and hit MacKenzie Weegar. Byron is not known to be a dirty player was promptly suspended for 3 games. Weegar suffered a concussion.



2. Byron gets suspended for 3 games and Tweets an apology on Twitter



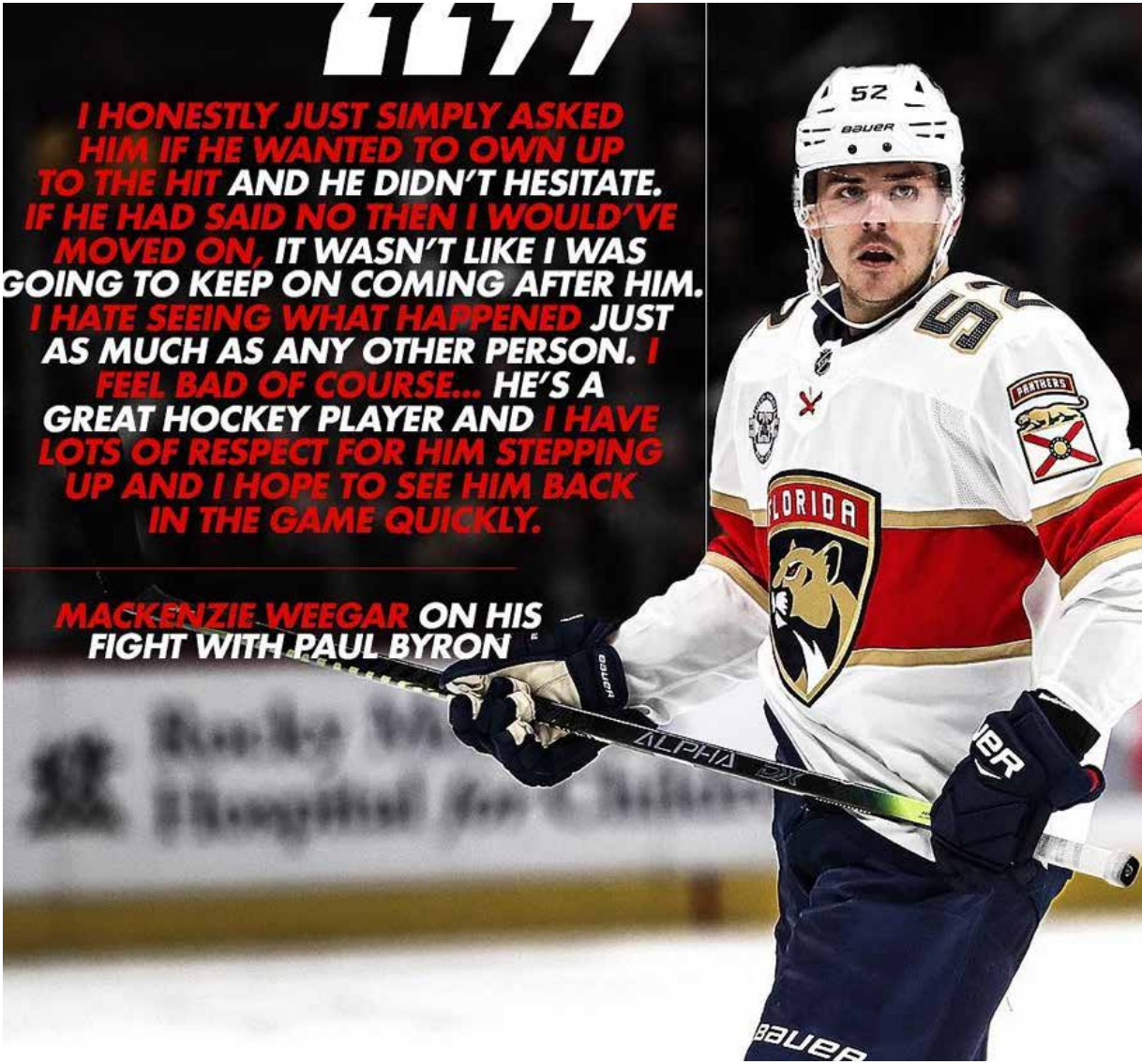
Paul Byron was suspended for three games and fined \$18,000 in salary by the NHL’s Department of Player Safety on January 16th, 2019. Byron released a statement via Twitter offering sincerest apologies to Weegar.



3. March 26, 2019

Early in the first period, Mackenzie Weegar states that he simply went to Paul Byron and asked him if he would like to own up to the hit from January. Weegar overpowered the fight in size and power due in large part to the weight and height difference. Weegar is 6” and weighs 200lbs and Byron is 5’9” and weighs 164lbs. Byron accepted and received a solid uppercut to the head, he hit the ice and needed help to get off the ice and did not return to the game. Byron suffered concussion following the blow to the head from Weegar.

Mackenzie Weegar was quoted saying “For The Code, for myself, I know that if I did something dirty and somebody wanted to challenge me, I would own up to the code., I would answer the bell. It’s just how it worked out.”



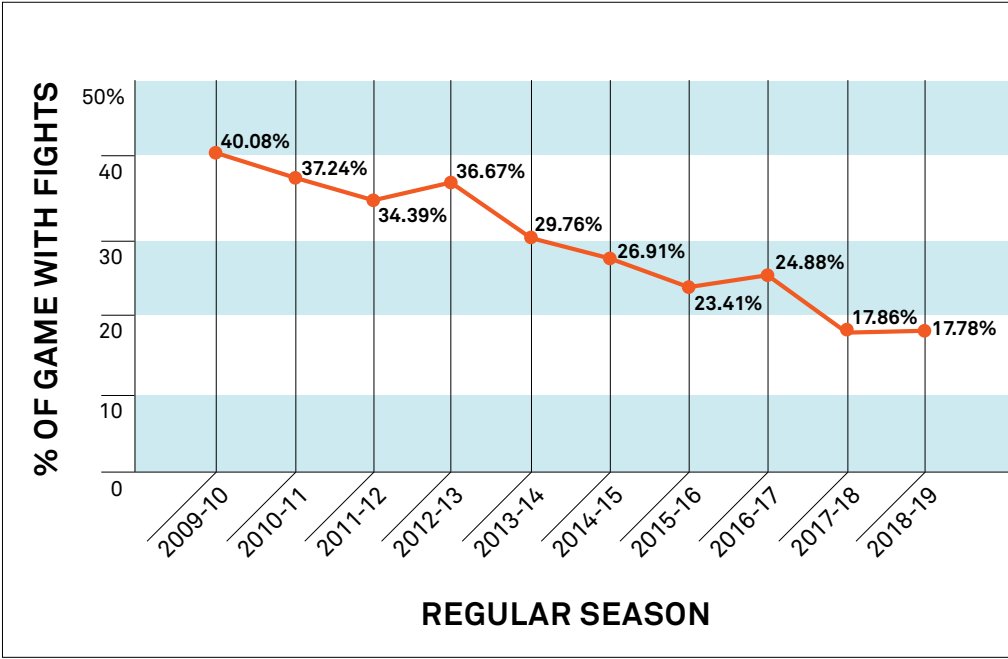


Statistical Analysis

Last 10 Season

In the book *Major Misconduct, the Human Cost of Fighting in hockey*, author Jeremy Allingham points out that “fighting has decreased 84% since the 1987-88 NHL season.”¹ The 2018-19 Regular Season had the fewest fights in modern NHL history, with a total of 226 fights. (17.78% of games with fights) The graph below illustrates the slow decrease of hockey fights per season in the last 10 NHL seasons.

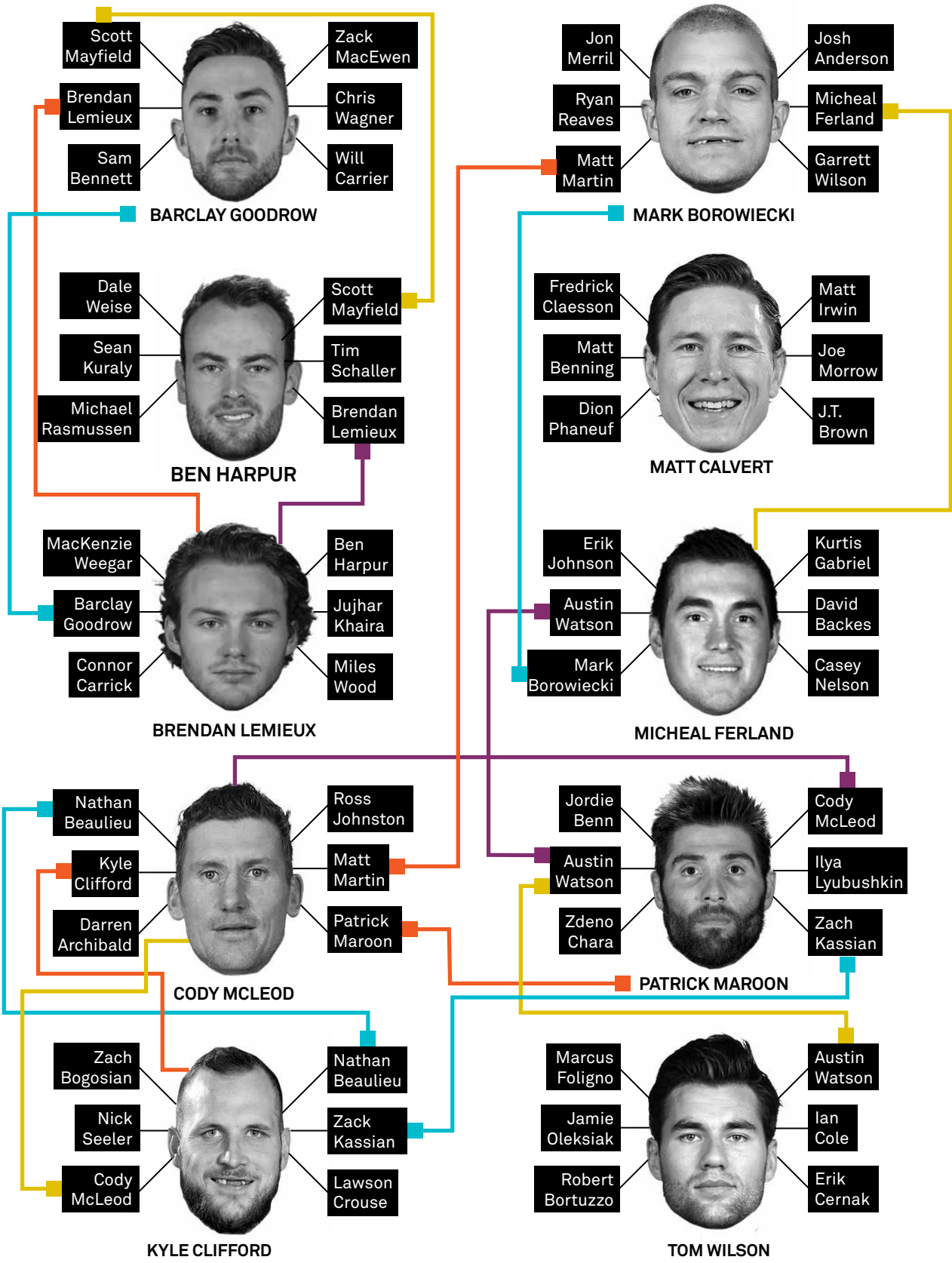

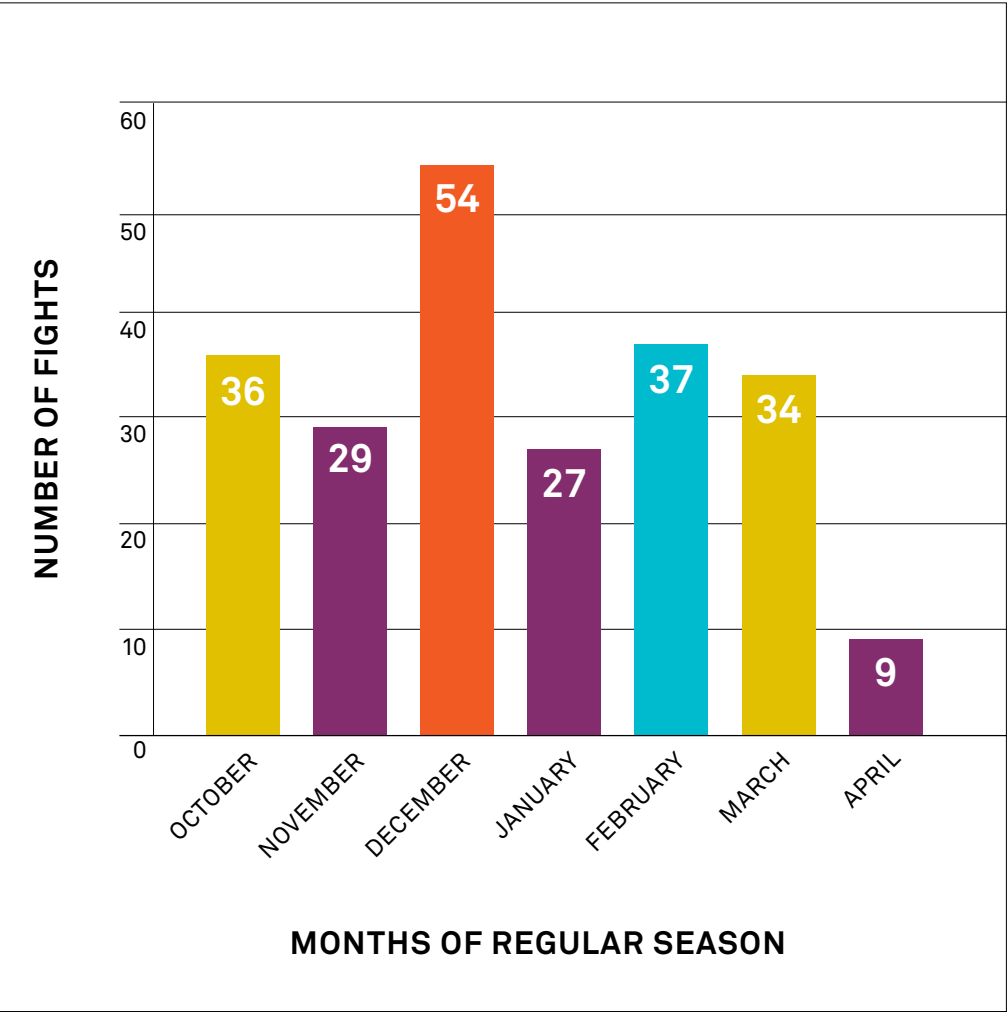

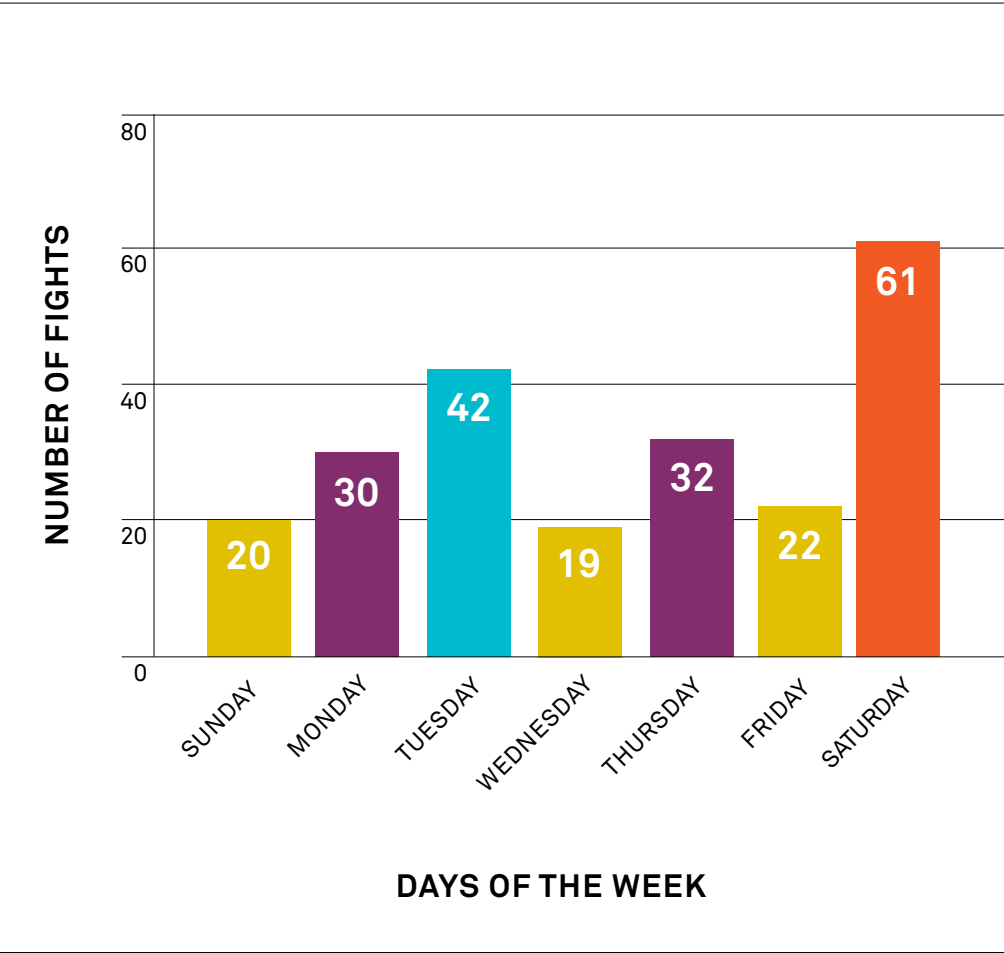
Number of Fights per Month

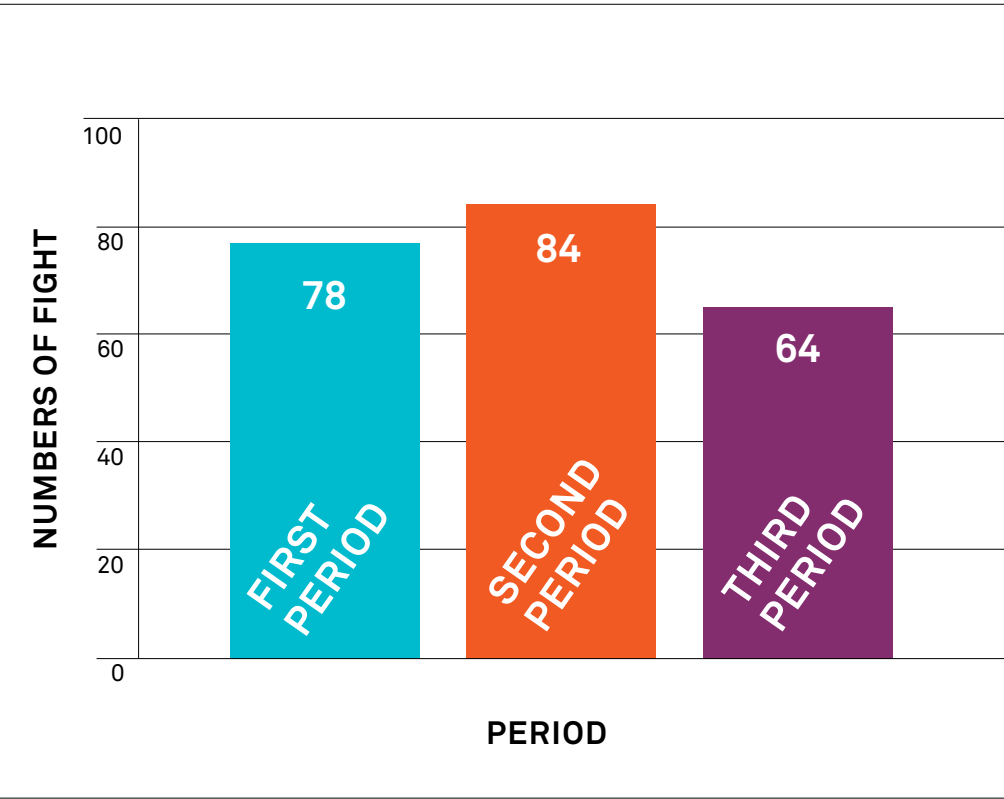
Number of Fights per Day of the Week

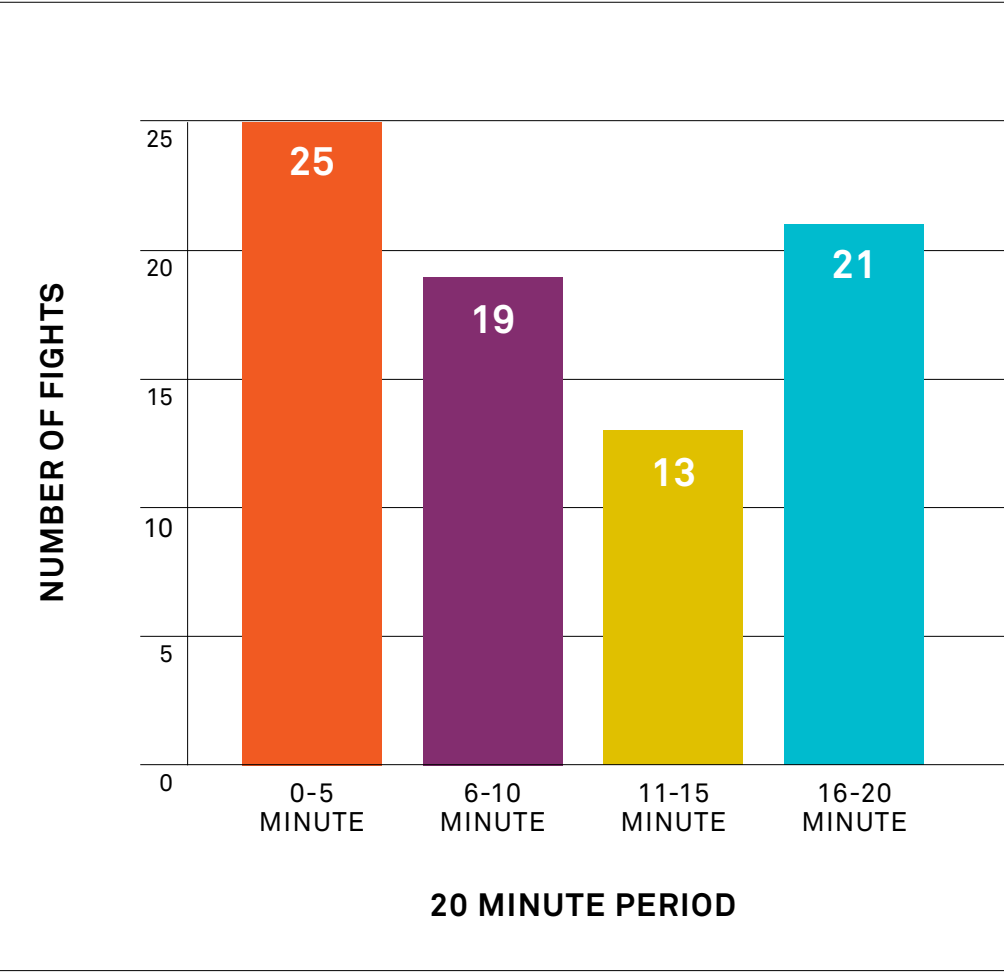
Fights per Period

The second periods of games with fights saw a marginally higher amount of fights during the NHL 2018-19 regular season. Most interesting is looking at the individuals graphs for each periods. We can see that the start of the first period at the 0-5 minute mark has a higher number of fights and may be the settling of scores from previous games played. Lower fights can be seen in the early part of the third period at the 0-5 minute mark as teams are more conscious of keeping their lead or trying to score to get the lead. Significant was the last 5 minutes of the third period at the 16-20 minute mark where we can see a spike in fights. During this time, teams have less to lose in regards to the game. Tension builds as players want to settle scores for events that may have erupted during the earlier part of the game.



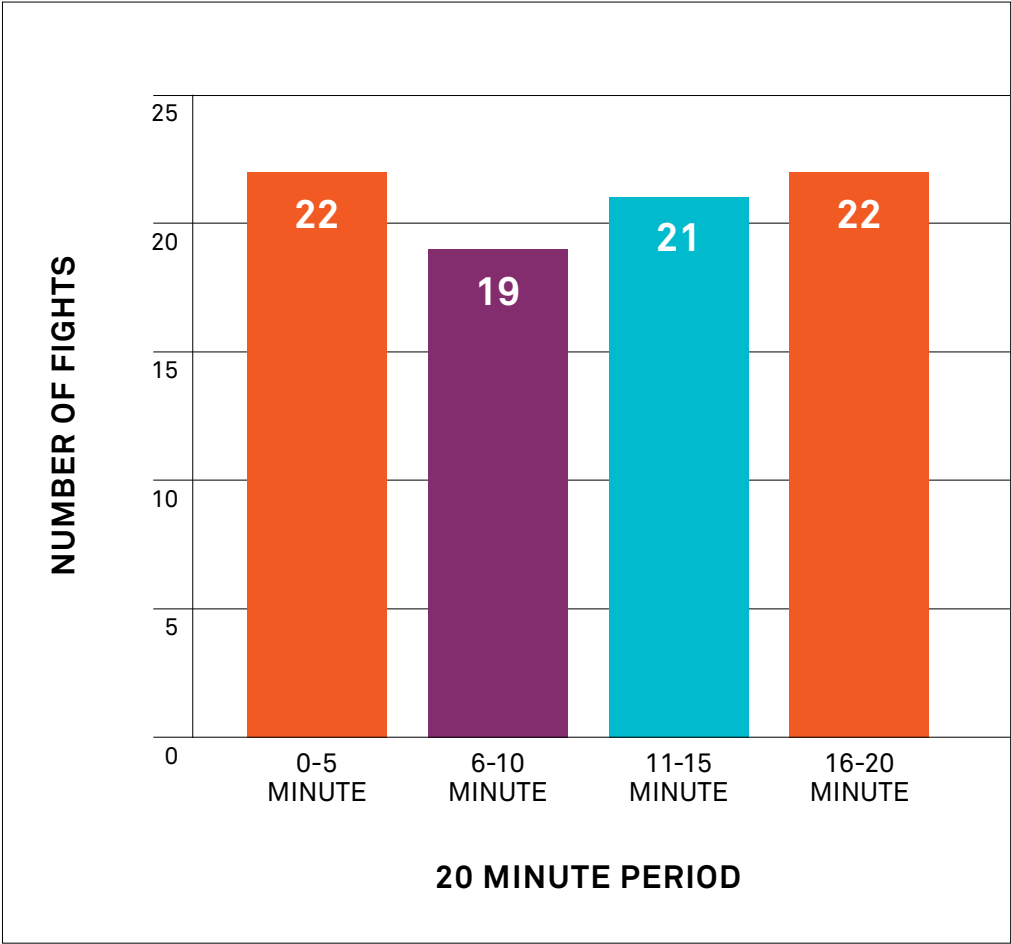

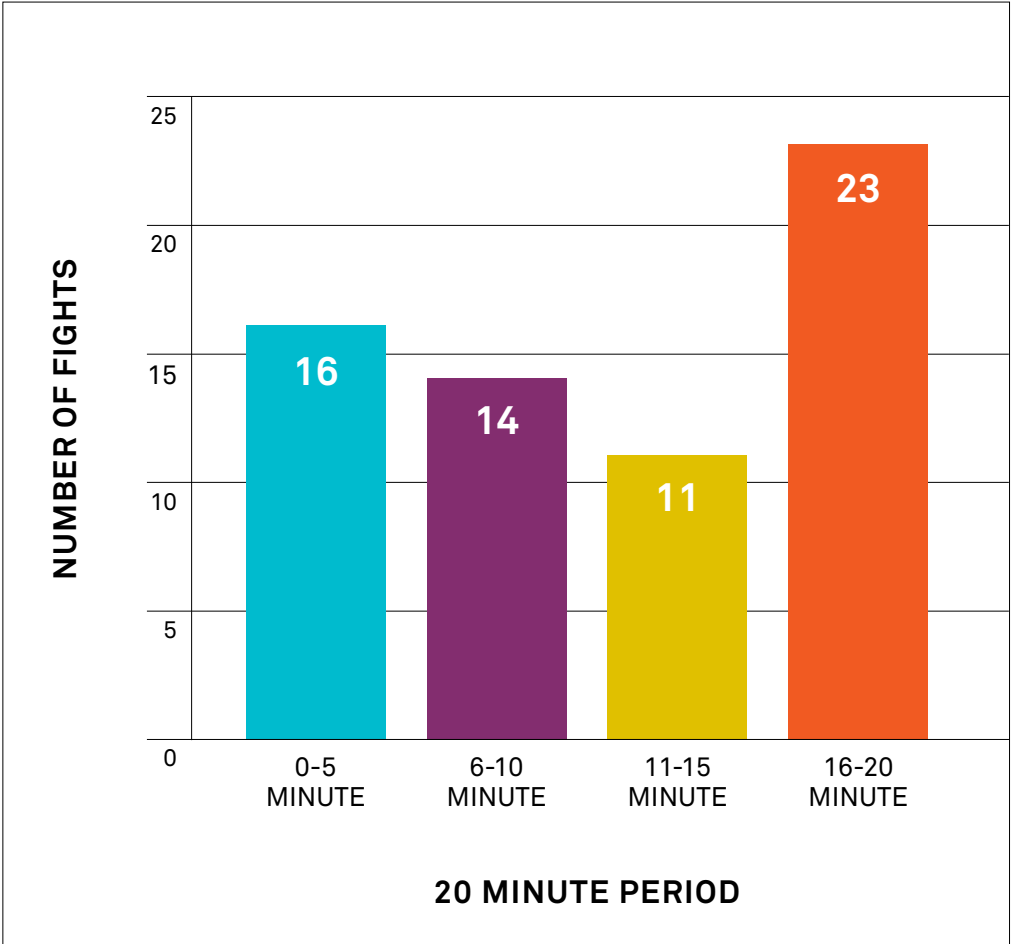

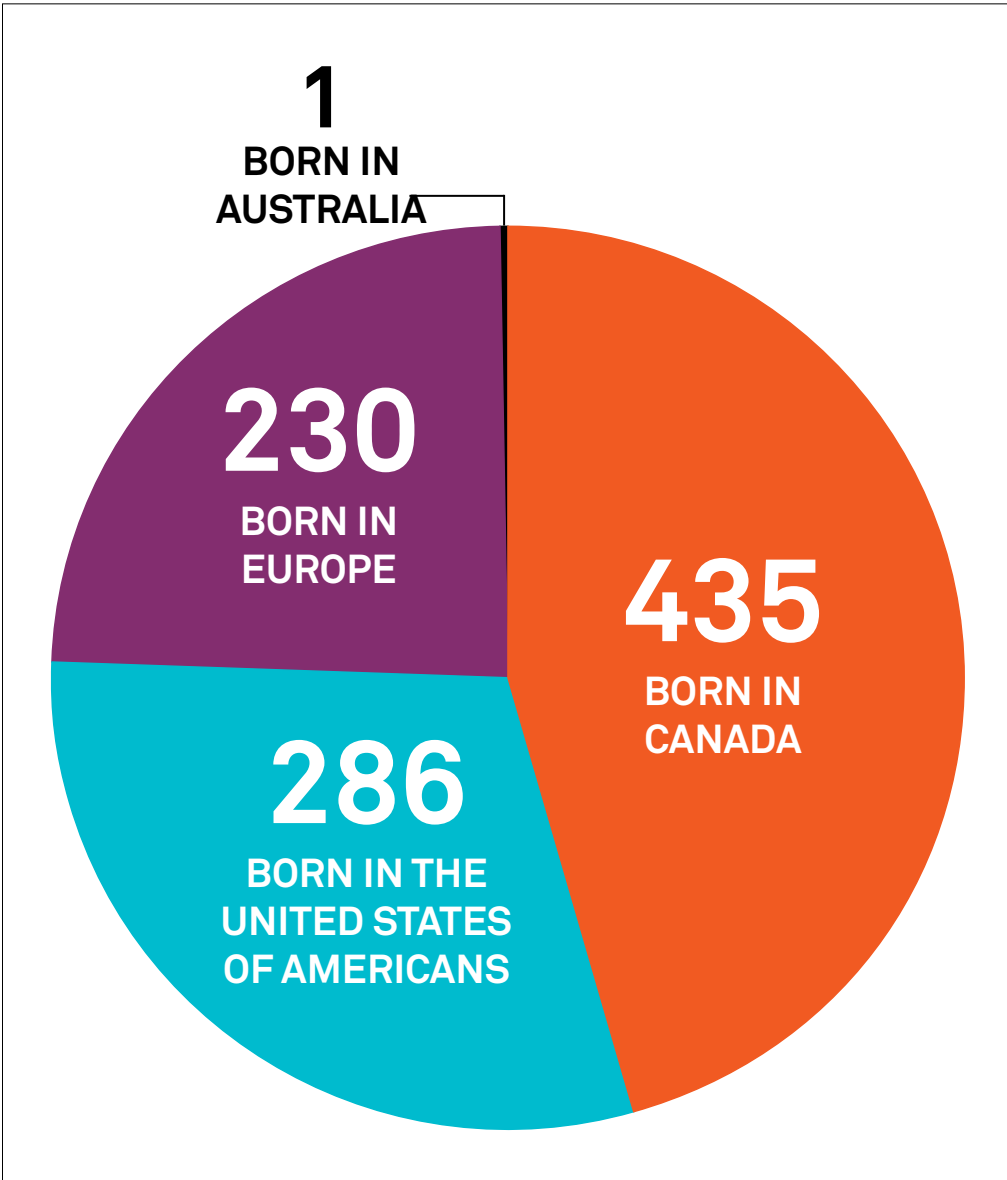

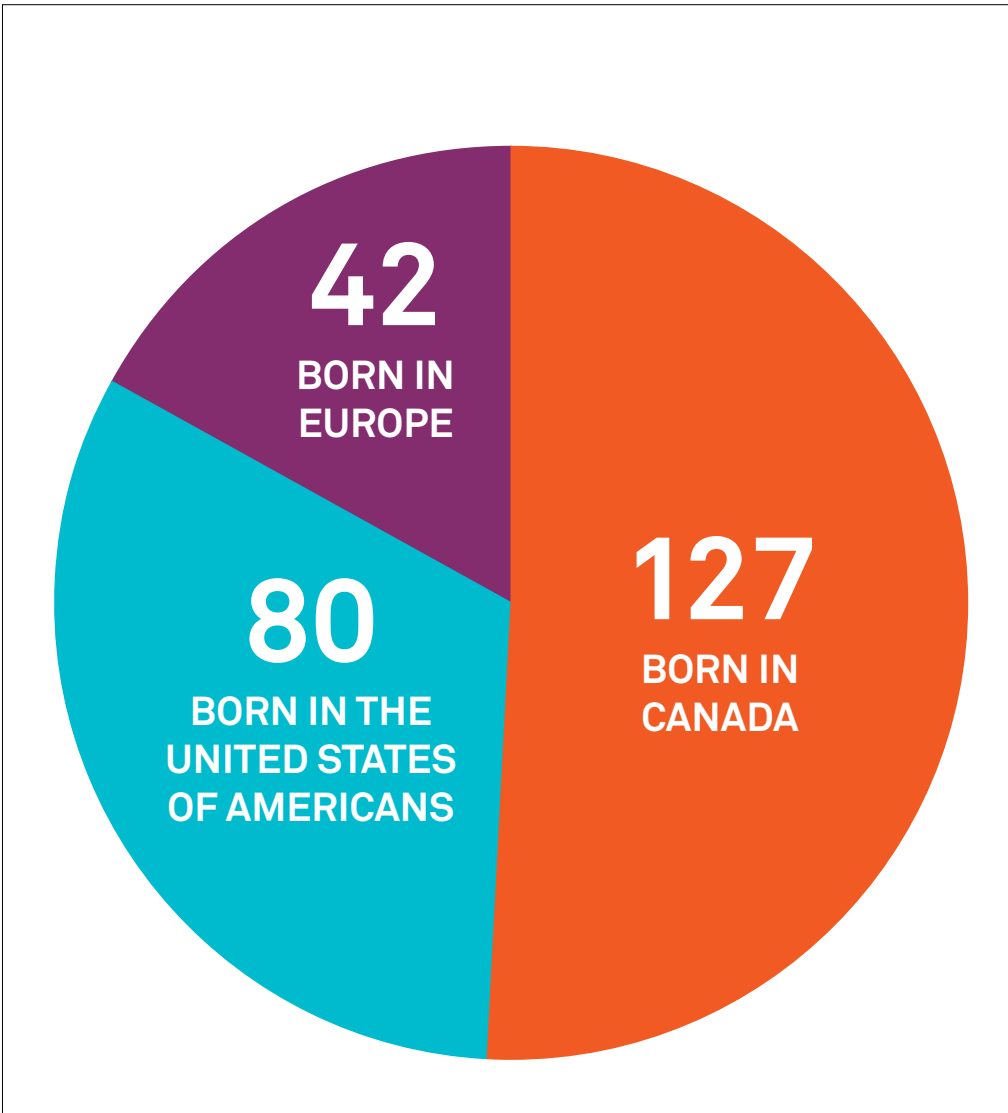
Canada has the largest number of NHL players, followed by US, Europe and one player from Australia.

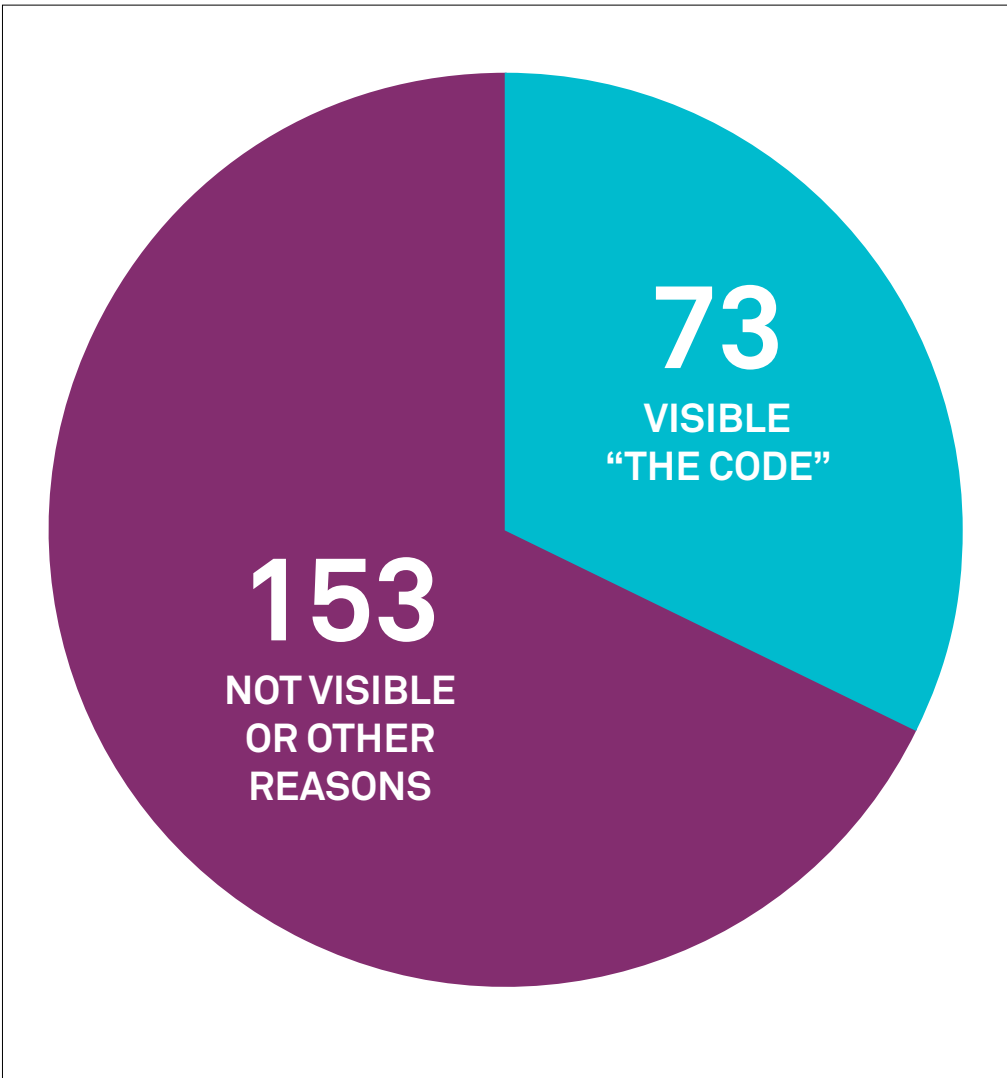

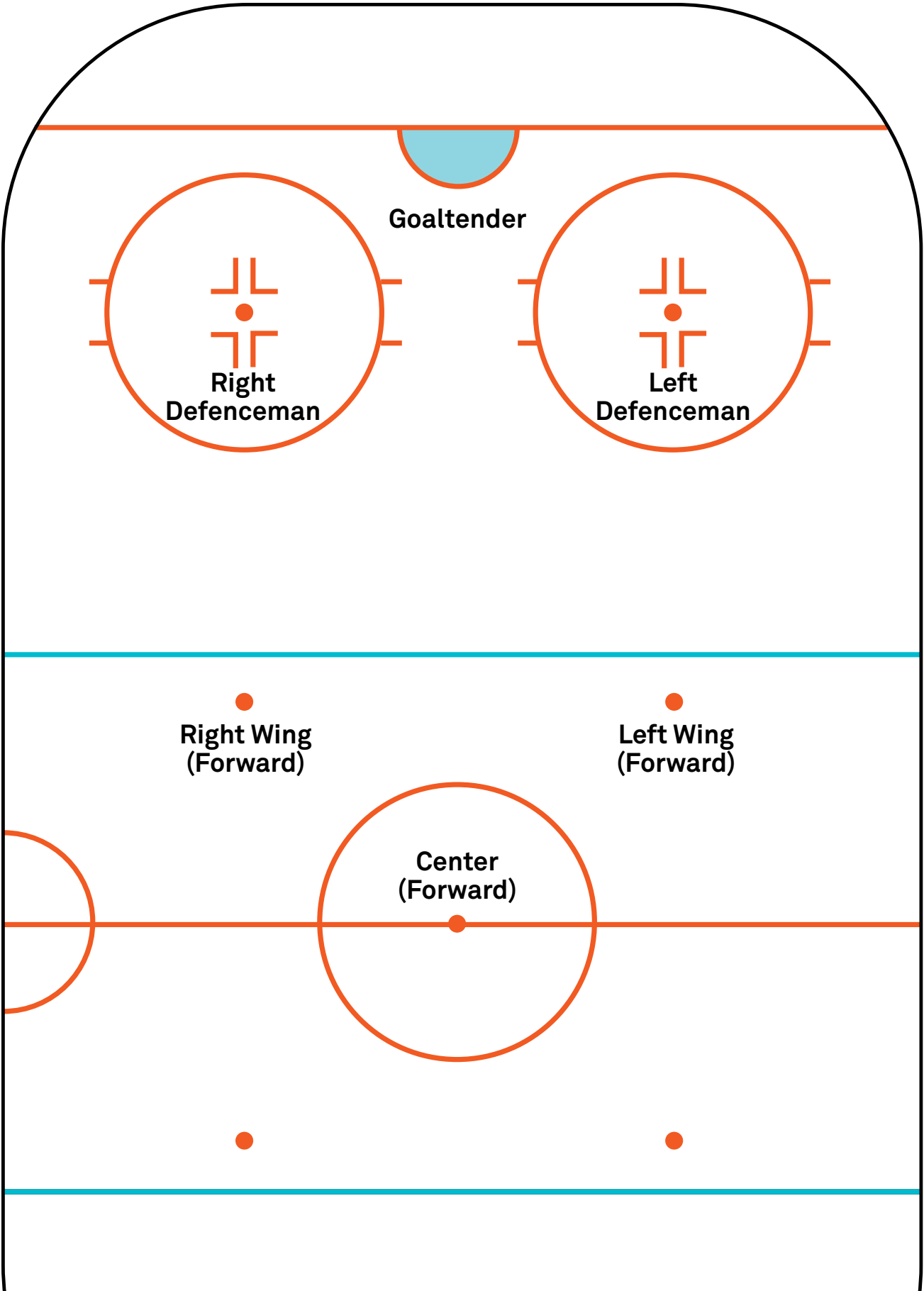
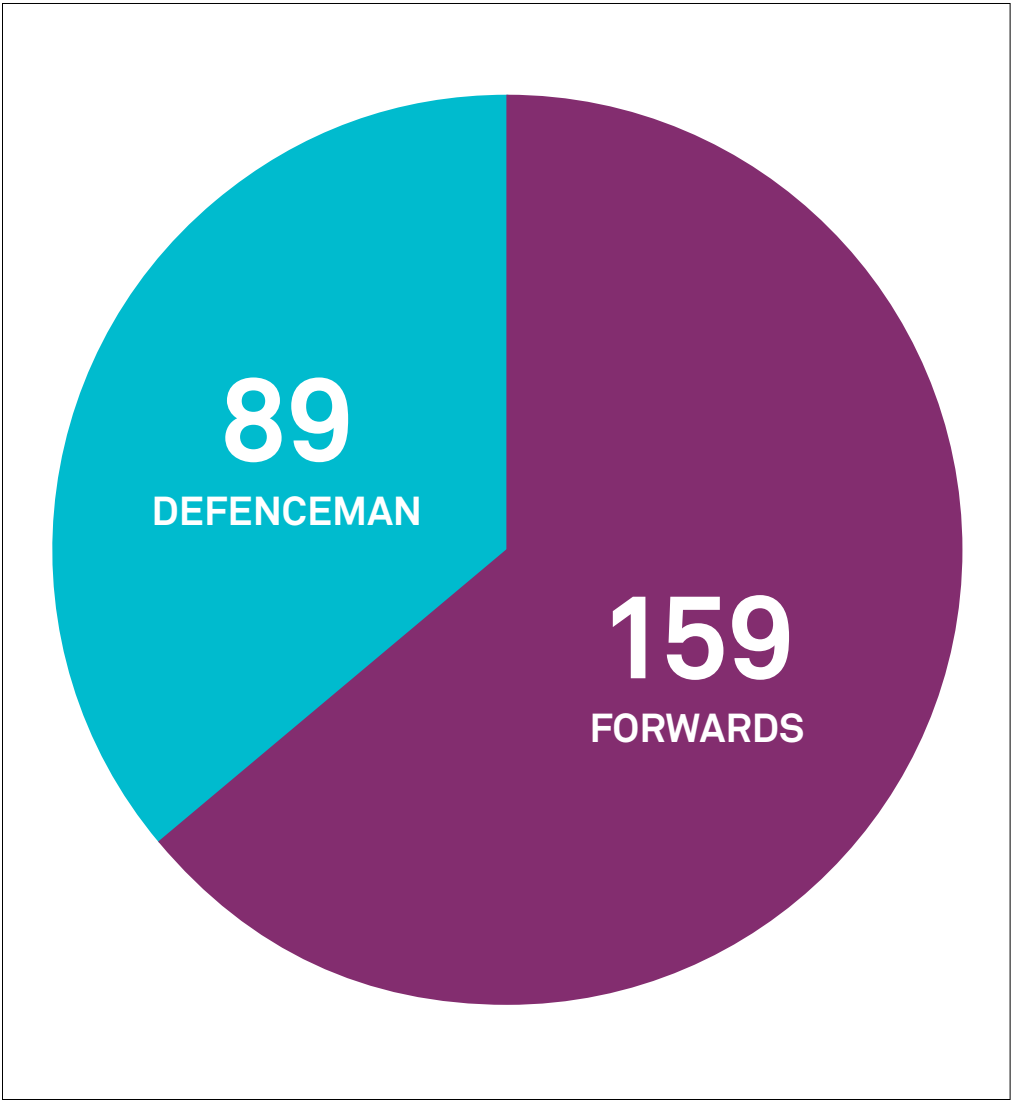
I witnessed 73 fights with “the Code” visible in action, where a player fought in honour of a teammate enduring a rough play from an adversary.



The clearest fight using “The Code” was visible in fight number 136 on January 17, 2019 between Bruins, Zdeno Chara and Blues, Patrick Maroon. Chara and Marron fought following a Blues players knocking Bruins, Charlie McAvoy. After fight. Chara slaps Maroon on the stomach as to say “no hard feelings”. As Chara skates to the dressing room, McAvoy hits him with his stick as a sign of recognition and Chara touches McAvoy’s helmet as to say “No problem buddy/I’ve got your back”.

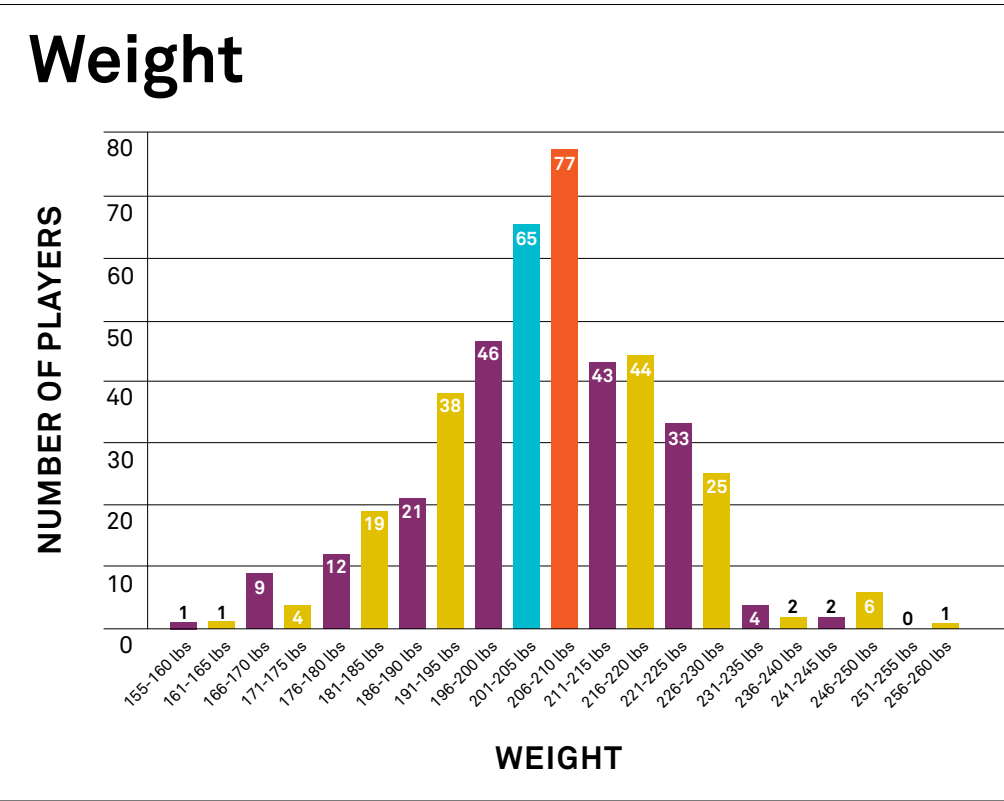
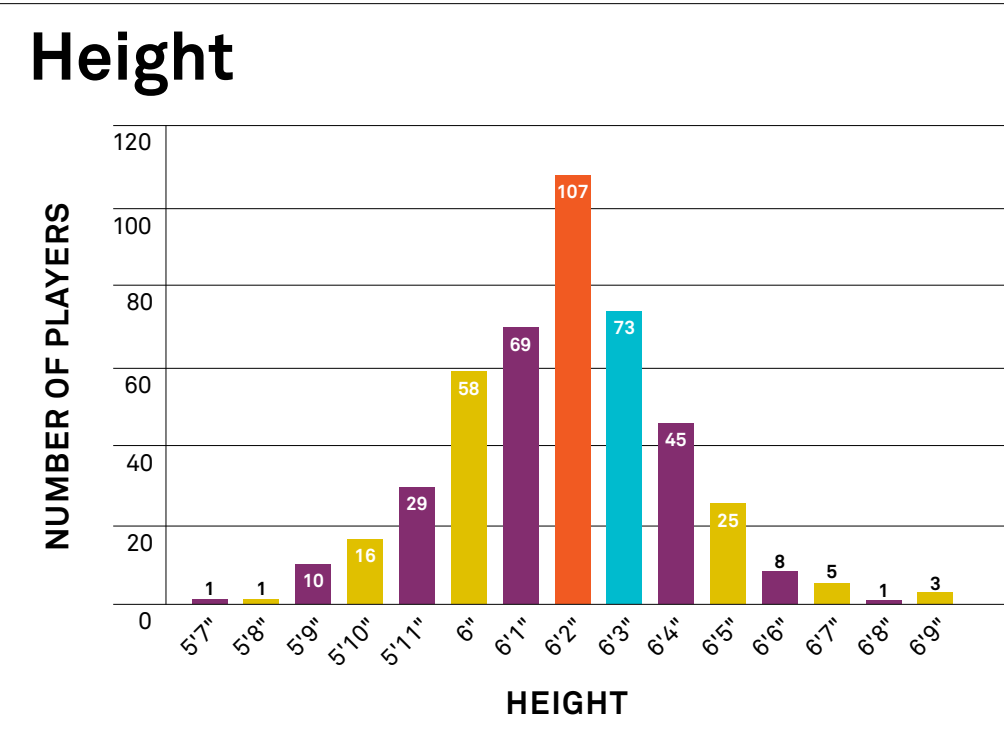
Players Position

Six players per team are on the ice during normal play: one goaltender, 2 defenceman and 3 forwards. Zero goalies were involved in fights, 159 forwards and 89 defenceman were engaged in fights during the NHL 2018-19 regular season. The graph below demonstrates that players position fighting have little to do when describing fighters.



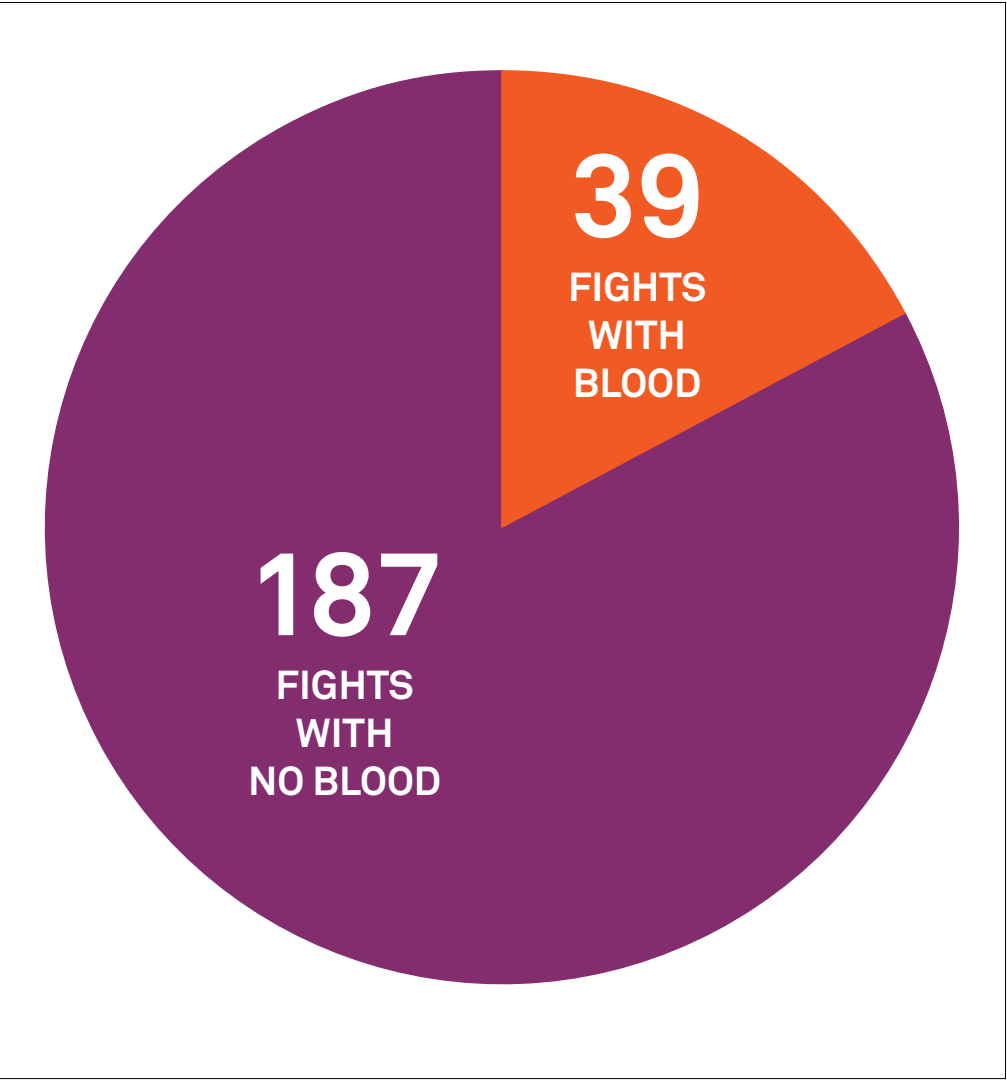
Weight & Height of Fighters

A large majority of fighters are between 6’1”- 6’3” weighing between 201-210 lbs. We can conclude that the smaller players do not partake as much in fights. Example, fight number 211 on March 26, 2019, between Paul Byron of the Montreal Canadiens and Mackenzie Weegar of the Florida Panthers, Byron received a hit and fell immediately to the ice. When Byron got back up his skates, you could tell he was hurt and struggling to keep his balance while leaning on one of the linesmen. He was escorted off the ice and went directly to the dressing room with the help of a member of the Canadiens medical team and a fellow team-mate. Byron is a small player, 5’8” and weighs only 158 pounds mismatched with Weegar, who stands at 6’0” weighing in at 212 pounds.



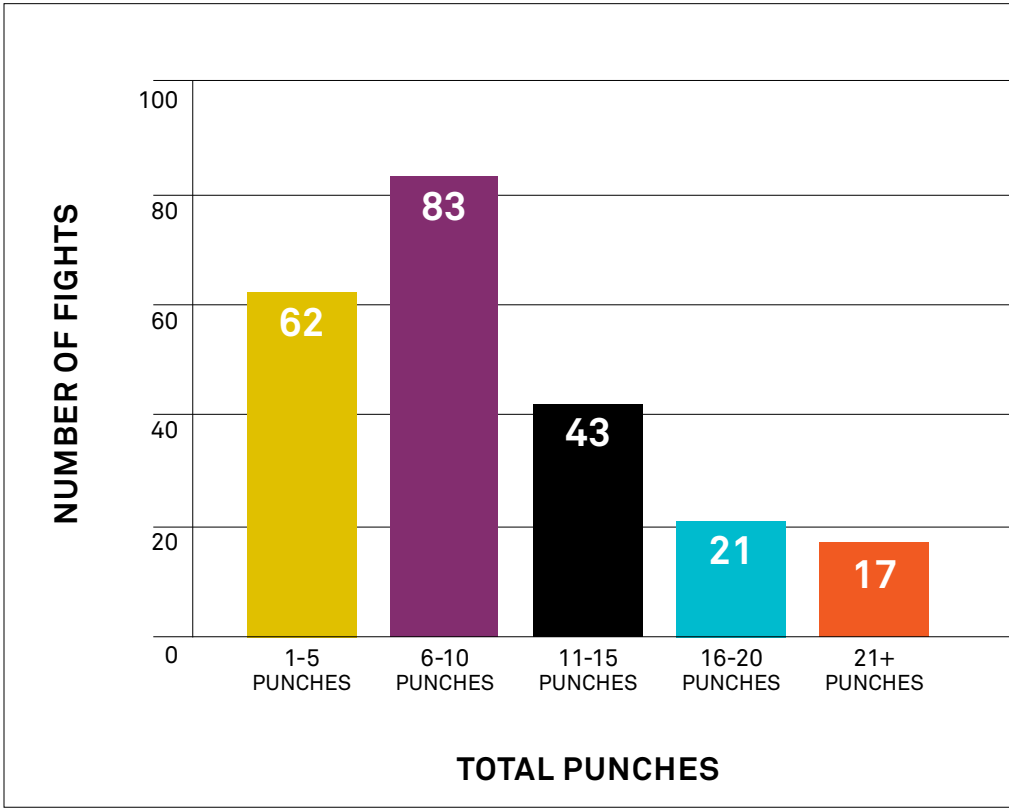
Number of Fights with Visible Blood on Video

I viewed 39 fights with visible blood on the fight videos. The blood was mostly on the fighters hands or faces. Most punches were directed at the head of players. Fighters try to punch off the opponent helmet resulted in hands and face lacerations from hitting hard helmets and visors.

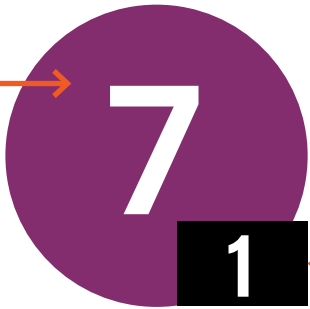


Numbers of Punches per Fight

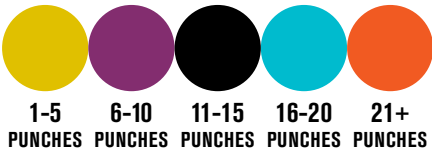
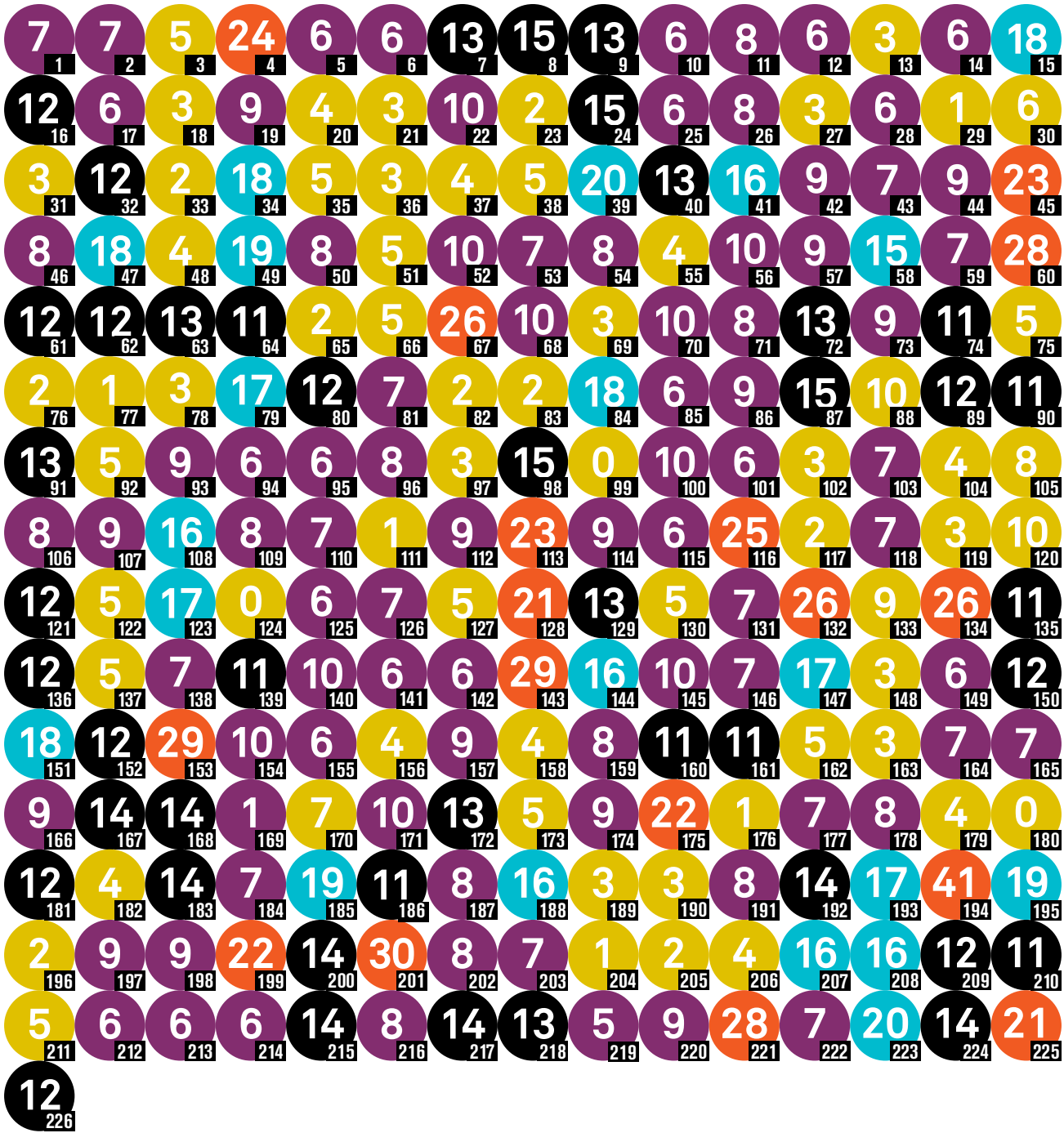
Of the 226 fights in the season a large number of fights, 145 fights were between 1-10 punches per fight. Rare were the fights with over 21 punches, (17 fights). Fight number 194 reached the top of punches at 41 punches. The total number of punches was 2,201. Most punched were directed at the head and neck area of the fighters.

0 to 5 Rating per Fight

Each fight was given a number from 0 to 5 rating system to evaluate the brutality—a five rating indicating very violent and 0 not very violent. 127 of the 226 of fights rated between 3-4 while 53 fights stood between 4.5 to 5. A mere 47 were evaluated between 0 to 2.5. Indicating that most of the fights fell on the higher side of violence.
