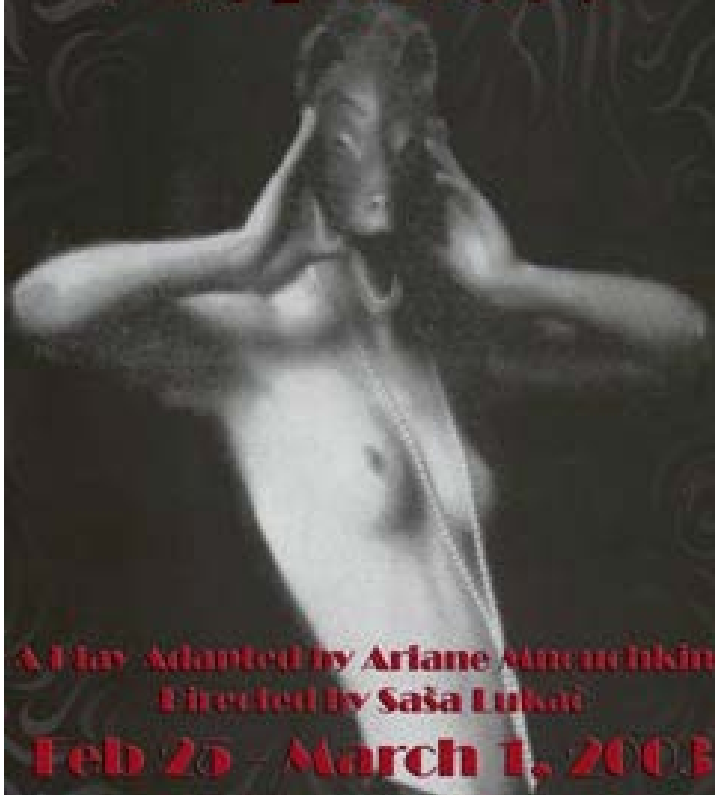

The novel lay underground for decades and was finally adapted by Ariane Mnouchkin in 1976 and inspired the 1981 Academy Award-winning film of the same name, "Mephisto". .

This epic story spans thirteen years, from 1923 to 1936. It follows the lives of ensemble group of political actors in Hitler's Germany.

This poem by W.G. Archangelsky (1878) was set to music attributed to the N.N. Ikonnikov and sung as a funeral march for the Russian revolutionaries who died in 1905. Resistance groups in Buchenwald, and probably in other Nazi concentration camps, sang it illegally in memory of their murdered companions
