woodland glade, *Allegro*

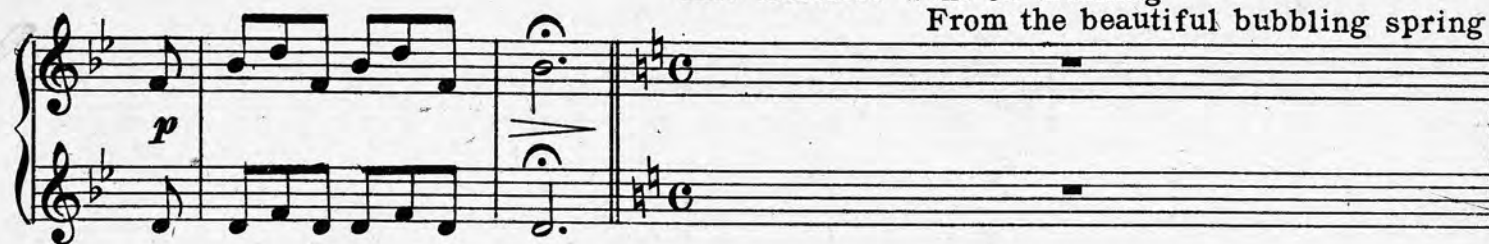
espied the pretty

approach of the hunter

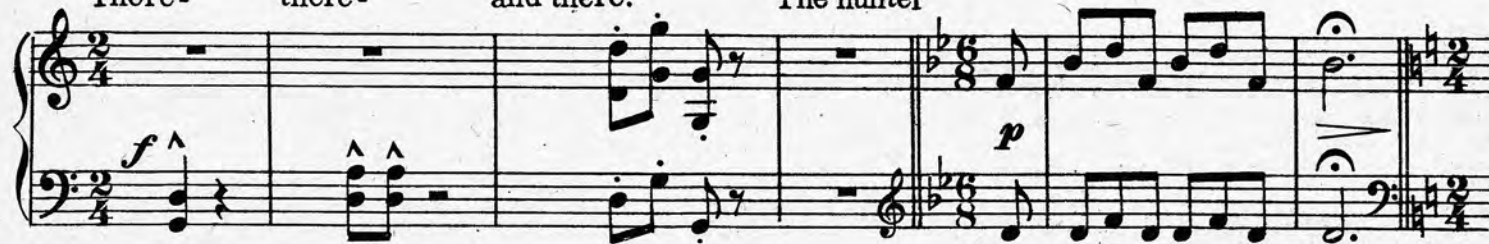
And therefore went on drinking
From the beautiful bubbling spring



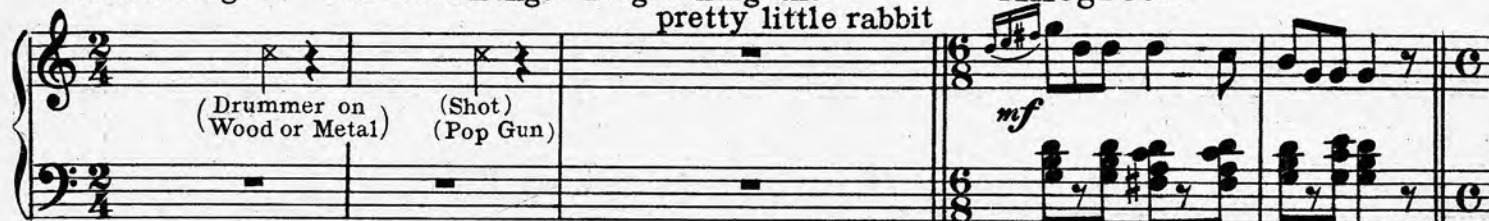
Surrounded by the
