


Community-based economies that enable equitable wellbeing while respecting ecological limits

- 2) *respecting ecological limits*?




1. Problematic Situation




2. Focus & Frame a Triggering Question



3. Articulate Observations (NGT)




4. Clarify Meaning (Neutral inquiry)




5. Inductively Cluster (Affinity)




6. Create Shared Language




7. Assignment (Voting)

Influence Map


