Ins and Outs tells the story of the female journey through first love. Told through a series of monologues and flashbacks, the play meditates on the presence of the past and how important a role the past plays in who we become in the future.

KugelMenschen

KugelMenschen tells the story of two individuals who have long forgotten what it means to be faithful to oneself. Marked by disappointment and abandonment, one became a pretentious cynic who wants to be taken seriously, while the other escaped society's fangs physically by leaving her hometown to find a place where she belongs, to find home. KugelMenschen is a comedy discussing subjects such as superficiality, brutalization, escapism, and the struggle for love.

Piecemeal

Set in a restaurant, 'Piecemeal' glances into the lives of a couple with a singular past, a family coming apart at the seams, and a lone, waiting man, over the course of a meal that they are never given by a waiter who knows little about what he's doing. Bit by bit, the lives and feelings of the diners unravel, forming a makeshift image of an incomplete puzzle.
