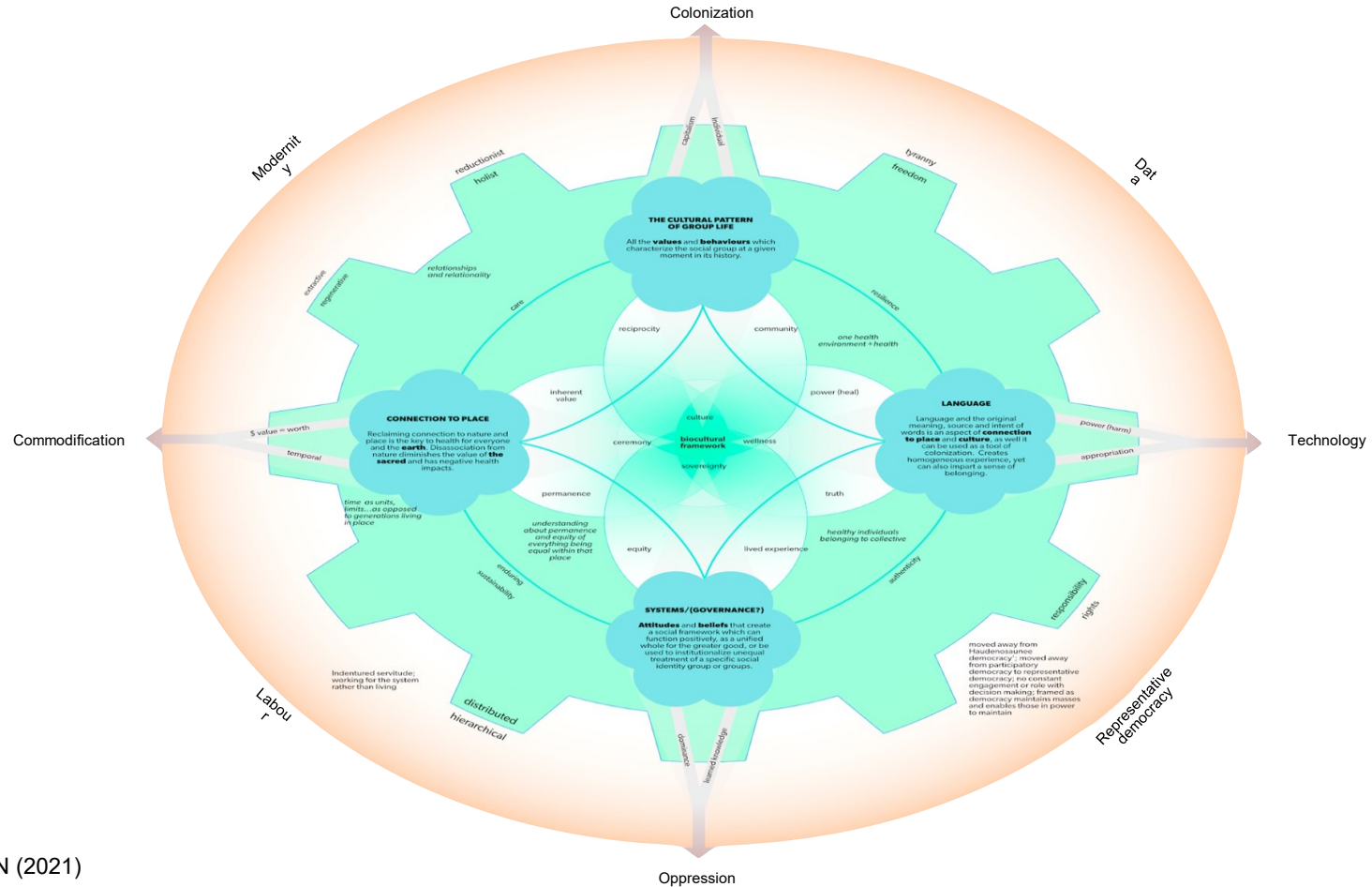

How do we make our cities better?

Central hypotheses

- Systems level interventions are possible if they are enmeshed within a holistic framework that is cohesive with established worldviews;
- Indigenous worldviews offer this holistic approach that could create the foundation for an interconnected worldview model from which a systems-level framework can be built;
- A systems-level framework prioritizing Indigenous worldviews will make our cities more equitable, less oppressive and less resource intensive; and,
- Creating a systems-level, city-building framework would provide the structure to create an approach, a set of guidelines, and an urban design 'toolkit' to change our cities.
