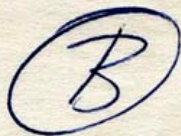
## POSSIBLE SYMBOLS

- ① A symbol using the characters CN, that will appear in white on a blue, rectangular shape. This shape will be the height of the lower white stripe on the proposed coach re-design and as wide as the distance from the edge of the door to the beginning of the first window. The symbol will sit by itself on the side of the train without any further explanation, i.e. spelling out Canadian National

- ② A symbol similar to No. 1 but including within it (small) the words Canadian National.
- ③ A symbol (more abstract) that will appear in conjunction with the words Canadian National on the sides of coaches; by itself on the engines and in conjunction with the words Marine, Communications, etc., when required. This symbol, I feel, will still have to be an abstraction of the letters C N.
