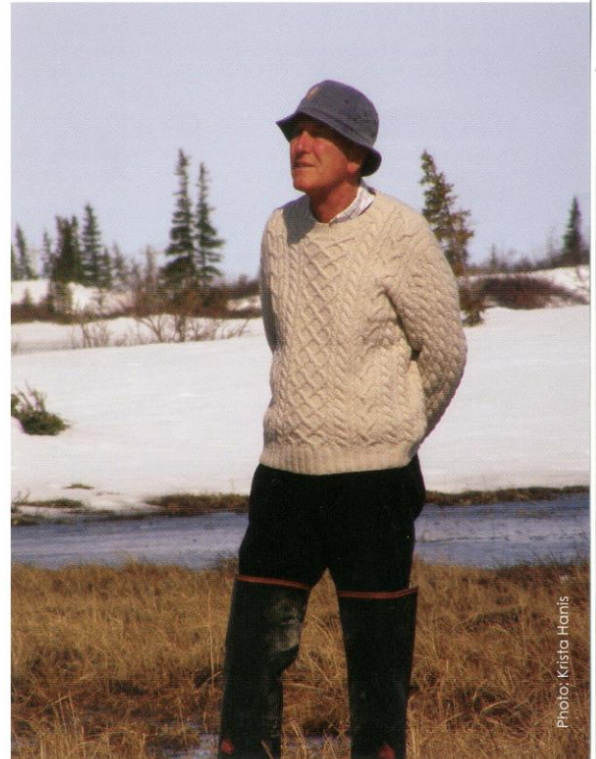


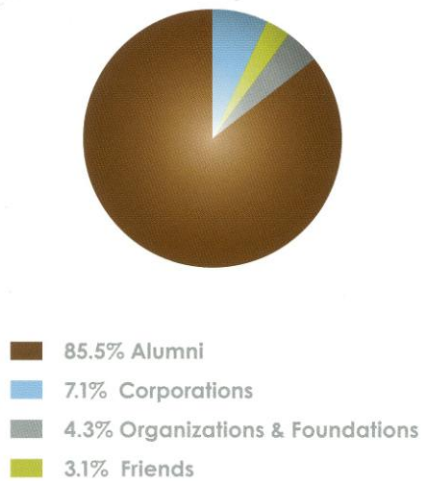
PROFESSOR ROBERT JEFFERIES

SCHOLARSHIP HONOURS CLIMATE CHANGE EXPERT

Professor Emeritus Robert Jefferies had been a respected member at the Department of Botany (later the Department of Ecology and Evolutionary Biology) for over 30 years, when he passed away in 2009. One of the top Arctic scientists and global change biologists, he documented the consequences of changing climate and wildlife populations on the region. His efforts played a major role in setting North American wildlife management policy. He was, moreover, an inspiring teacher to the over 32,000 students of ecology who took his BIO 150 and other courses. Donations by family, friends and colleagues to the Robert Lenthall Jefferies Graduate Award Fund will be used to create a permanent tribute to a scientist, teacher and role model who was unflagging in his encouragement of others to make a positive difference in the world.
