

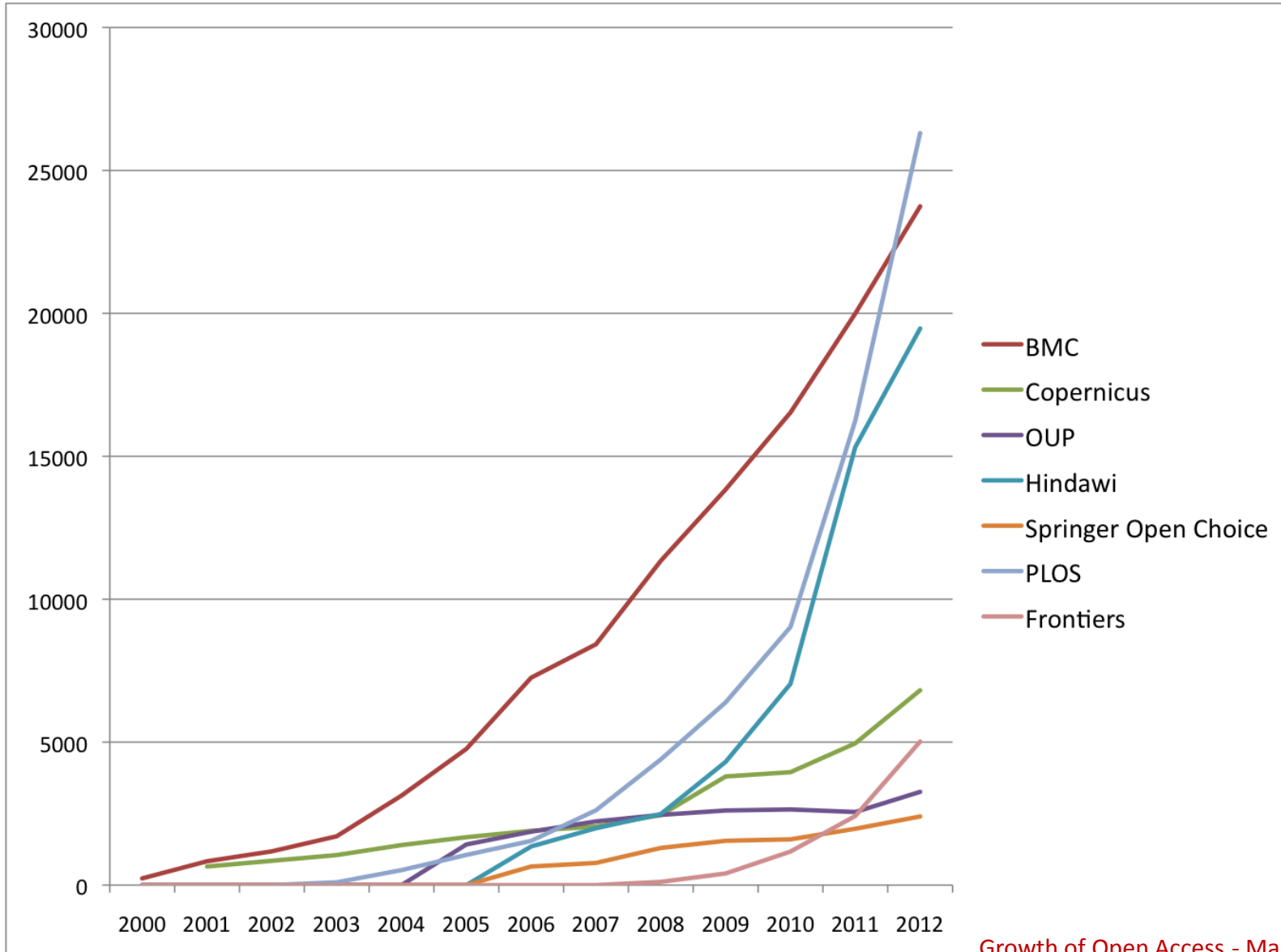

Growth of Open Access - Major Publishers.

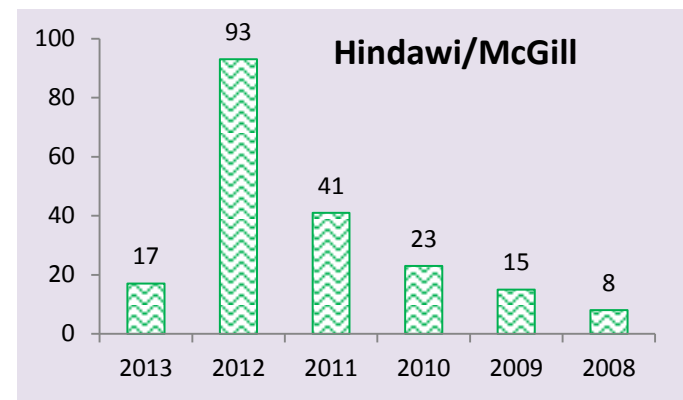
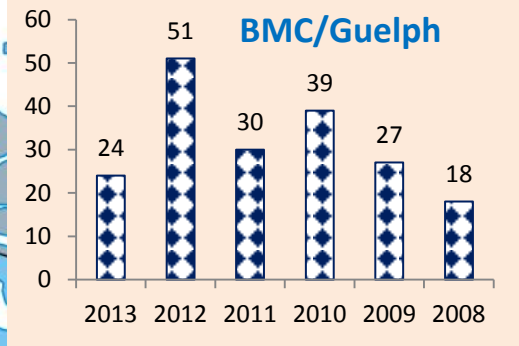
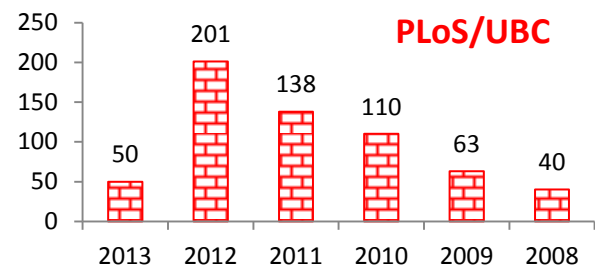

## SFU Open Access Fund

Beginning February 2010 the SFU Library is pleased to administer a central fund to support SFU authors who publish in Open Access journals that charge Article Processing Charges. Details of the fund, as approved by the Senate Library Committee at its meeting January 18, 2010, are as follows:

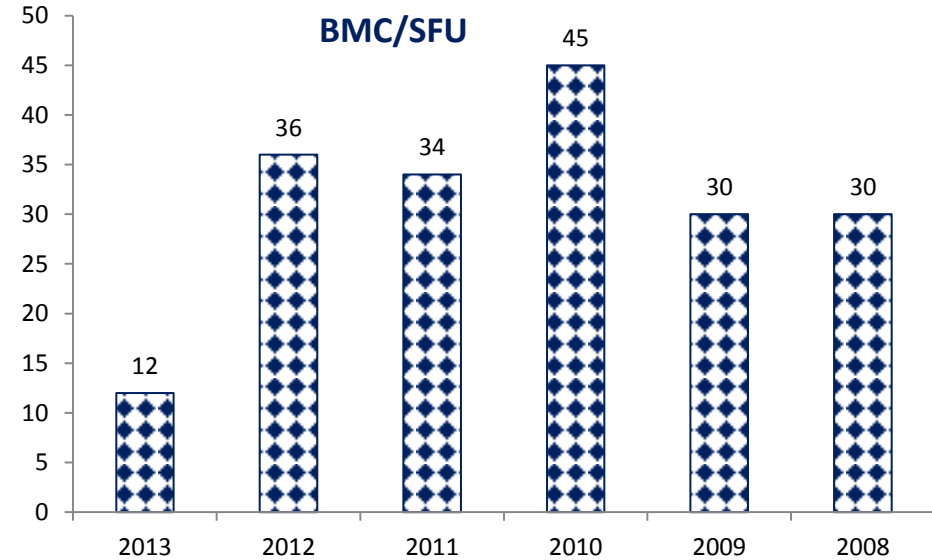
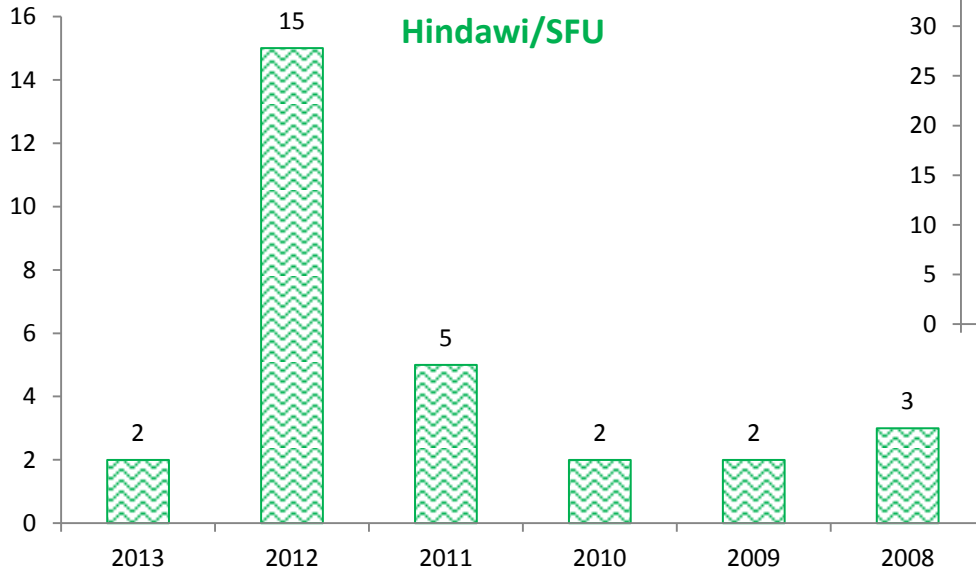
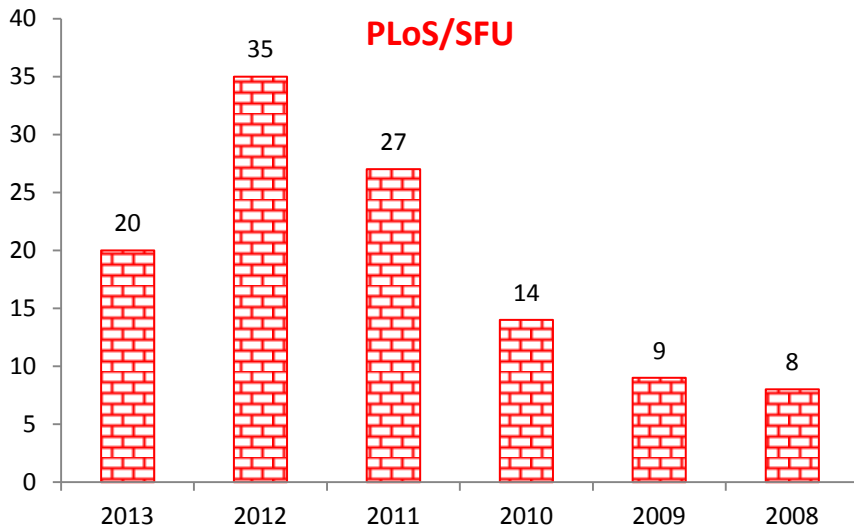
SFU authors who are faculty, staff or graduate students are eligible to use the Central fund. Undergraduate students working under the supervision of faculty member are also eligible.

The Library has established memberships or direct invoicing arrangements with some of the most prominent open access publishers. If you submit an article to one of the publishers listed below, the library's membership arrangement will cover the article processing charges if you are eligible.

Direct invoicing arrangements are only possible when the **submitting author** is identified as being **affiliated with SFU**.

## Open Access Authors' Fund

The Open Access Authors' Fund is designed to pay the fees charged by publishers for articles to be published in Open Access (OA) journals. These fees are often referred to as "author fees", "author payments", "open access charges", "article processing fees", or "submission fees".

The Open Access Authors' Fund is provided by the Libraries at the University of Manitoba. The Libraries initially began supporting UM researchers OA fees for certain publishers in 2010/11, but beginning October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 we will extend coverage to all open access journals that are eligible.

### Application Procedure

- Applicants should first read the information on this page and then complete the [application form](#). Please also read information provided in [Frequently Asked Questions \(FAQ\)](#).
- The fund is open to all faculty, staff, graduate students, and postdoctoral researchers at the University of Manitoba. Adjunct professors and faculty whose primary appointment is at another university are not eligible.
- Applications will be reviewed as quickly as possible. Normally, applicants will hear whether their funding request has been approved within five working days.
- The Libraries will support no more than one OA fee per applicant in a fiscal year or up to a maximum of \$3,000 CAD. An application form is needed for the accepted paper and the applicant must be the submitting author.
- Applicants should exhaust other options before applying to the Open Access Authors' Fund that permits payment of submission fees before applying to the Fund.

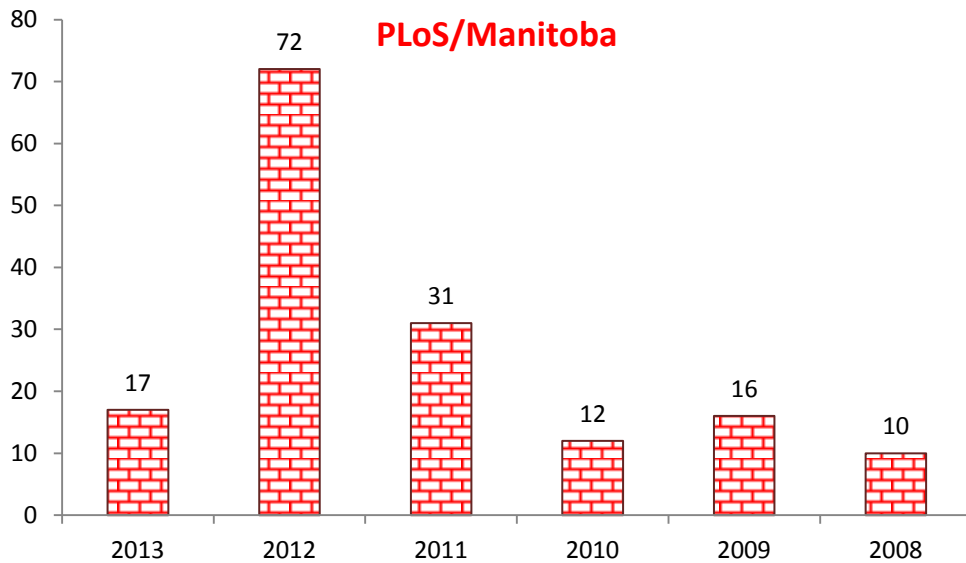

Memorial University Libraries have established an open access authors fund to pay Author Processing Charges for Memorial researchers who wish to publish their work in open access journals.

#### Who can apply?

All Memorial, faculty, graduate students, staff, post-docs, emeriti, and honorary research profs who have had a peer-reviewed article accepted to an Open Access journal that meets the funding criteria.

Where an article has multiple authors, at least one of these authors must be a Memorial affiliated researcher.

Memorial Libraries will fund a maximum of \$3000 per year for each researcher, at a maximum of \$3000 per article.

Researchers with no other funding source to cover APCs will be given priority over those with research funding available for this purpose.

#### What does the fund cover?

The fund will cover Author Processing Charges (also called author's fees or page fees) for articles that have been accepted to "gold" open access journals that meet the following criteria:

Open access promotes broader access to academic research by scholars, students, professionals and the general public.

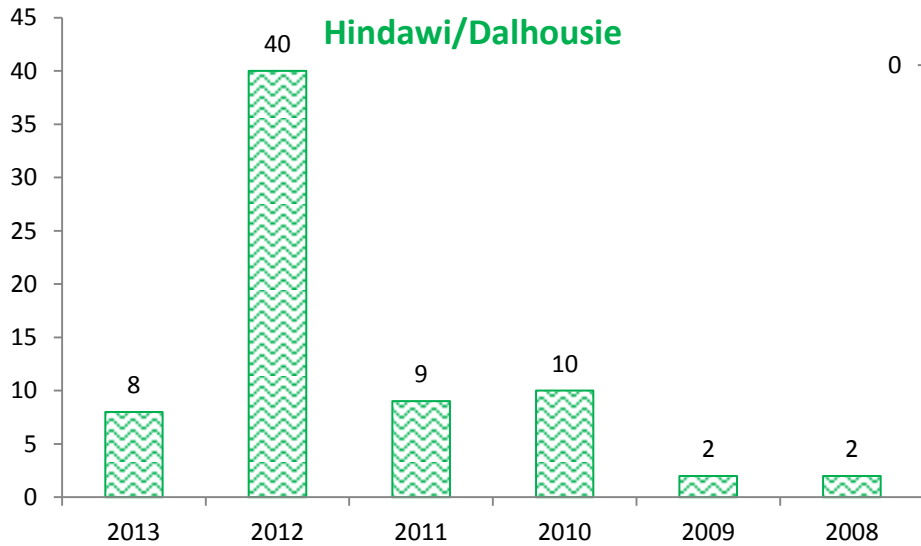
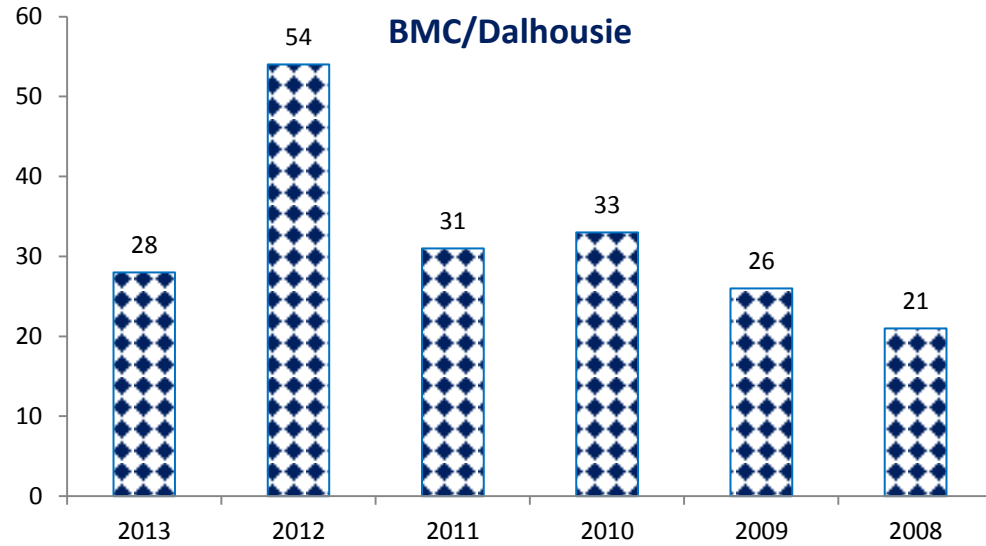
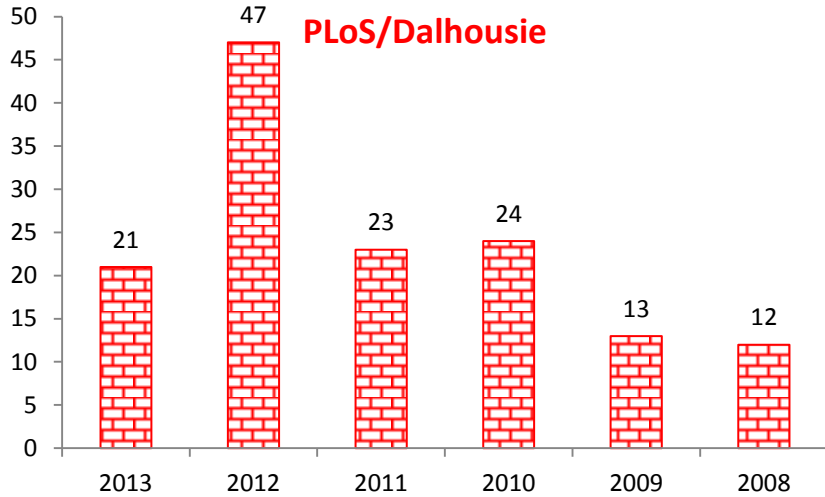
The Dalhousie Libraries subscribe to many OA journals. The open access publishing model is of particular value in the fields of Science, Technology and Medicine (STM), and the BioMed Central and SpringerOpen OA collections are two of the most significant recent additions to our STM acquisitions. (SpringerOpen also includes some titles in other disciplines such as humanities, math, and pastoral studies). Dal Libraries have just become a "supporting member" of these two major ejournal publishers. This means that Dalhousie authors who wish to publish in a journal produced by either of these organizations will get a reduction of 15 per cent on the article processing charges (about \$250-\$300 per article). Any article submitted from a Dalhousie IP will automatically be provided with this reduced membership rate.
