 - ...



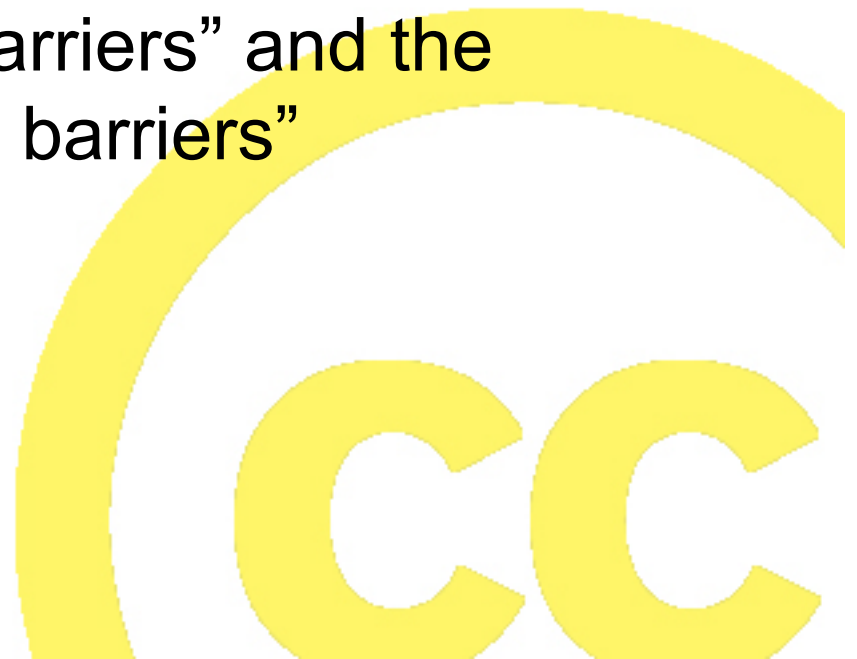
Open Access & Copyright

- Copyright is a bundle of rights...
- Open Access is made possible when copyright holders **transfer / license** some or all rights and **retain** some or no rights



The Different OAs...

- Green v. Gold OA
- Gratis v. Libre OA
 - The two degrees of OA
 - the “removal of price barriers” and the “removal of permission barriers”



Green/Gold OA & Gratis/Libre OA

	Gratis OA (removing price barriers)	Libre OA (removing both price and permission barriers)
Green OA (through repositories)	1	2
Gold OA (through journals)	3	4
