What do we mean by Open Access?

Scholarly content online that is free of charge, and free of most copyright and licensing restrictions.

(paraphrased from Peter Suber)

Primarily aimed at ***peer-reviewed*** research articles which authors give to publishers without ***expectation of payment***.

- Open Access provides users with the right to “**read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of articles**” subject to ***author attribution***.

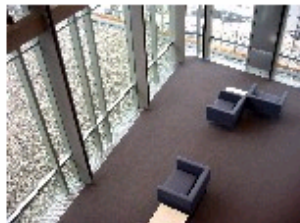

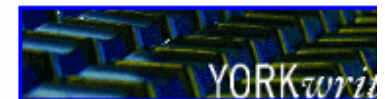

Other option to make article OA

Hybrid Open Access Journal

- Publish in Hybrid Open Access Journal. Also called OA by the Article, Optional OA, Paid Option for OA, or Author Choice, etc
- This refers to a journal where only some of the articles are Open Access. This status typically requires the payment of a publication fee / processing fee to the publisher
- Processing fees covered by CIHR Grant

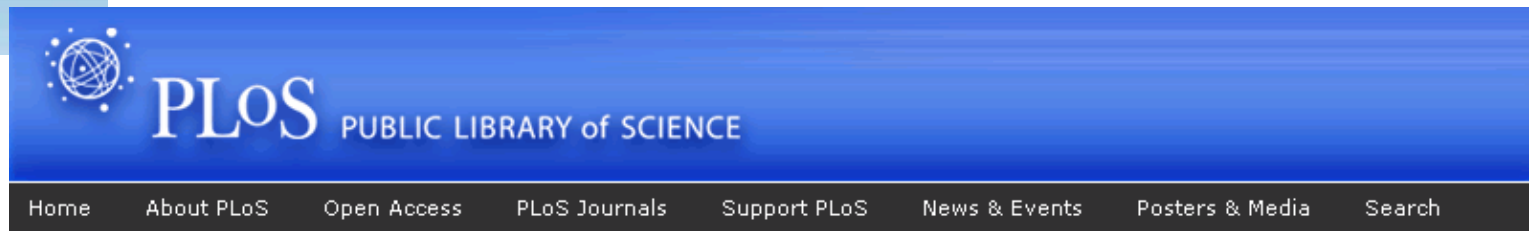
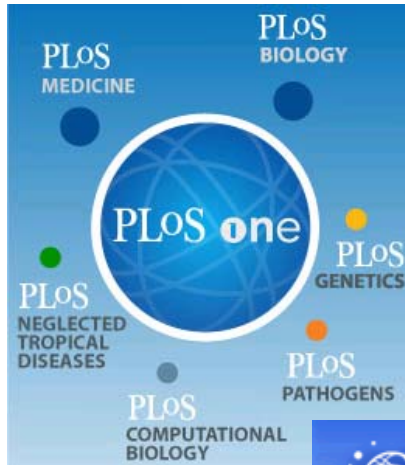

Option#2 Author Self-archiving

- (Green Route): Grant recipients must archive the **final peer-reviewed** full-text manuscript upon publication in a digital archive such as the [YorkSpace](#) institutional repository OR
- PubMed Central Canada (in process)

Green Route - Open Access & Institutional Repository

- Green open access route – Authors deposit their **final peer-reviewed manuscripts** in YorkSpace upon acceptance for publication
- Simple upload procedures (5 mins)
- Librarians will train graduate students and faculty in uploading documents to the repository

Author Deposit Process

1. Check Copyright and Self-Archiving Policies of Journal in SHERPA ROMEO
2. Deposit **final peer-reviewed manuscripts** in YorkSpace

SHERPA ROMEO

- What is a pre-print?
 - In the context of the RoMEO database a pre-print is the version of the paper before peer review process.
- What is a post-print?
 - In the context of the RoMEO database a post-print is the version of the paper after peer-review, with revisions having been made.

SHERPA ROMEO

- RoMEO uses different colour designations to differentiate between four categories of archiving rights. This colour coding was developed by the SHERPA RoMEO project team.

Romeo Colour	Self-Archiving Policy
Green	Can archive pre-print and post-print
Blue	Can archive post-print
Yellow	Can archive pre-print
White	Archiving not formally supported

Abstract: This paper will present a survey of game theoretical applications to peace and war relevant to the continuing debate on the theory's place. (Some contributions are by Deutsch, 1954, 1968; Waltz, 1959; Quandt, 1961; Snyder, 1961; Shubik, 1968; Robinson, 1970; Rosenau, 1971; Junne, 1972; George and Smoke, 1974; Plon, 1976; Martin, 1978; Wagner, 1983; Maoz, 1985; Snidal, 1985a; Hardin, 1986; Larson, 1987; Jervis, 1988a; O'Neill, 1989b; and Rapoport, 1989.) The review will be non evaluative, and will focus on the areas chosen for applications rather than developments in the mathematics. It will be fairly comprehensive in the international relations (IR) section, and include the main subjects in the military operations part. In regard to IR, I examine the mutual influences of the mathematics and the conventional theory or policy questions. The military section notes the interaction of game applications with new military strategy and technology. A companion paper (O'Neill, 1990b) surveys introductory writings for each game theory subfield that might be relevant to IR.
